These new spaces will enable us to expand our work, support more makers and, for the first time ever, open to the public year round to offer a rich community and youth education programme.

LEAVING A GIFT IN YOUR WILL

Your legacy can help us pursue our mission to cultivate a thriving, equitable craft sector, enabling our core work of supporting maker businesses to start up, grow and thrive.

You can also support our youth, careers, community and education activities and

our new public events programme, all of which open up craft to everyone.

Making a will and keeping it up to date ensures that what you leave behind has an impact you can be proud of.

HOW TO GET STARTED

When you consider leaving a gift in your will, we suggest you follow a few easy steps:

- a. Seek professional advice from a solicitor and financial advisor. They will explain the different kinds of gift you can leave – pecuniary (a specified sum of money), specific (an item or asset) or residuary (the remainder of your estate, or a percentage of it, once family and friends have been provided for).
- b. Provide your solicitor with our charity name, address and registered charity number. You may find the following wording useful:

'I leave the sum of £___ to Cockpit Arts, Cockpit Yard, Northington Street, London, WC1N 2NP (registered charity number 1029643) for its general purposes. I further direct that the receipt of the Chief Executive or the Chair of Trustees of the said charity shall be a valid and appropriate form of discharge to my executors.'
- c. Tell your loved ones that we are named in your will to avoid surprises.

OUR COMMITMENT TO YOU

If you are able to leave us a gift in your will and choose to do so once you have looked after your family and loved ones, we promise that:

- We will answer any question you may have honestly and quickly
- We will respect any decision you make, when you make it and whether you tell us or not or change your mind
- We will spend your kind gift wisely, sensitively and effectively to inspire the next generation of makers
- We will acknowledge your gift in our Annual Report and in our buildings
