FASHION

STEP 1

Start on the Third Floor in Studio 300.

CAWLEY STUDIO - Hannah Cawley founded her womenswear, menswear and homeware brand in 2017. The brand is known for its hand-cut pieces made from 100% natural fabrics. Celebrating British manufacturing, she offers high-quality ready-to-wear, bridal and bespoke garments.



STEP 2

Exit to the left and immediately enter Studio 301.

REBECCA PENRICE - Rebecca Penrice is a garment and accessories designer who joined Cockpit on the 2023 Dyers' Company Award. She uses pleating and smocking techniques in her practice, to add interest and uniqueness to classic materials.



STEP 3

Exit to the left and continue along the corridor to Studio 303, entrance on your left.

YUSSICO - Former solicitor Yusuf Osman was introduced to traditional British leather craftsmanship through a weekend course, which inspired a career shift to launch one of the finest hand-stitched leather accessories brands in the UK. His work has been exhibited at the Walsall Leather Museum, and he has collaborated with brands like eBay and Jo Malone.



STEP 4

Take the stairs or lift down to the Second Floor.

STEP 5

When you reach the Second Floor, head to Studio 213.

FORM WEBEN - Weaver Sven Steinmetz creates his one-of-a-kind seamless garments using a custom technique which implements forms based on the natural curves of the human body within the weaving process. In this way he creates both garment and fabric in the same moment, reducing waste and shortening the manufacturing process.



STEP 6

Exit to the right and walk past the lift and along the main corridor to Studio 208, entrance on your right.

MORENIKEJI TEXTILES - Kemi Ajose is a knitwear designer who hand creates all of her items on a hand-powered knit machine using deadstock yarns and materials. Her contemporary designs draw inspiration from traditional West African craft, incorporating a range of textures, colours and patterns into her trademark style.



STEP 7

Exit to the right and go left around the corner to Studio 205A, entrance on your left.

THE SHOEMAKERY - Maria McLean's aim is to make shoes that fit everyone perfectly. Her designs strike the perfect balance between hand and machine crafting, while also being designed with comfort, customisation and local production in mind. A must-visit for summer sandals!



STEP 8

Take the stairs or lift down to the First Floor.

STEP 9

When you reach the First Floor, head to Studio 107.

PHOEBE ENGLISH - Phoebe English is the founder of the eponymous award-winning sustainable circular fashion studio. Founded in 2011, she crafts high-quality, sustainable and aesthetically pleasing clothing using design practices aligned with planetary limitations.



STEP 10

Take the stairs or lift down to the Ground Floor.

STEP 11

When you reach the Ground Floor, head to Studio 004.

OWEN LEATHER - Harry Owen is a leatherworker specialising in hand crafted leather goods made exclusively from high-quality vegetable-tanned leather. Harry produces bespoke bags and cases alongside a range of wallets, belts and accessories, all meticulously handmade down to the finest detail.
